1. **How do I enroll my child/ren for the program?**

2. **PTA Membership required.**

3. **When does my child start submitting the worksheets?**

Grading will start from October 1st. Kids can start submitting their worksheets during the last week of September. Only 1 or a max of 2 sheets will be graded per week. Please click on the link below to download the worksheets and the due dates calendar.

4. **Where/who do they give the completed worksheets to?**

There is a folder-holder fixed on the wall, right outside every individual classroom. Your child can drop his/her worksheets directly into these holders. The assigned graders for each class will collect them from here every week.

Classes in portables: 2nd Grade: The folders are on the wall along the stairs near the exit door to the 2nd grade portables.

3rd Grade: The folders are on the wall along the stairs near the exit door to the 3rd grade portables.

5. **Will the performance impact their school grades?**

Absolutely not. This is a completely optional program which is run by England PTA. This does not in any way impact their school/academic grades/scores.

6. **Rules for Submitting the worksheets:**

Please make sure that the worksheets have the child's **FIRSTNAME, LASTNAME AND TEACHER'S NAME** written legibly. The worksheets especially the Kindergarten ones require that the child write their name by themselves (this is actually the 1st question on the sheet). Please allow them to write their names by themselves, but a parent/guardian/older sibling can add the other details like last name and the Teacher's name. This applies to **ALL** the 20 worksheets.

7. **My child has completed all the 20 worksheets of his/her grade. Can they work on the next grade?**

They can print and work on them at home, but only grade level sheets will be accepted and graded.

8. **What if my child misses a due date, can he/she submit along with the next week's sheet?**

Yes! That is the reason we are accepting a maximum of 2 sheets per week. (If they started on a later date, they can submit the worksheets upto the next upcoming due date)

9. **Planning a vacation?**

No problem! The dates' chart is planned keeping in view the Thanksgiving break, Winter break and Spring break. But if leaving for vacation before Winter break and your child would like to submit the **1st 10 sheets by winter break**, please attach a note to the grader along with the worksheets and submit them during the 1st week of December.

10. **Math Superstars Bulletin board? Where is that?!!**

If you enter from the car drop off entrance at the back, then the 1st section on the wall to your right is where the Math Superstars Bulletin board is. This year, we are trying something new for the wall. There will be special mentions by the end of each month on the wall, for kids who follow the due dates and other rules mentioned in #6 above (**NOT BASED on how much they score**). This is still an evolving idea. Will send updates if things change.
